My duties as Interim Commissioner on Governance is to address Anishinabek Governance Issues such as the Anishinabek Nation Chi-Naaknegewin Appeals and Redress, Matrimonial Real Property Law, Child Welfare Law, Synchronized Elections and Drafting a Community Constitution Template with input from the Union of Ontario First Nations. The Constitution Template is a starting point for individual First Nations to put into place Laws on how their First Nation operates. The end result would be Protection for the First Nation by detailing laws and rules on how the individual First Nation operates and it would provide accountability for the Citizens of the Anishinabek Nations both on and off reserve. The U.O.I. staff and I will be travelling to First Nation communities to get their input on developing this draft Constitution Template.

Recently I was invited to work with Chief Collins and the Robinson Superior Chiefs to deal with/ address the War on Drugs, whether it is illegal or prescription drugs. We have to work together to find a way to help Communities work to a Positive Goal. It is heart breaking and a tragedy to see/and hear what many families are going through.


