Airport Information

The Sault Ste. Marie region is serviced by two airports, one located in Sault Ontario, Canada and another in Sault Michigan, US.

(For all travellers entering the United States a passport and a visa is potentially required. Please make sure you have the correct travel documents before entering or leaving the United States.)

For those travelling in Canada or from overseas it is recommended that you fly into the Canadian Sault airport.

Driving Information

From Toronto, take **highway 400 north to highway 69**. Follow **highway 69** to highway **17W**. Follow **17W** to Sault Ste. Marie. Continue onto **ON-17 W/Trans-Canada Hwy/Trunk Rd** (Continue to follow Trunk Rd). Continue onto **Wellington St E**. Turn **left** at **Pine St**. Take the 3rd **right** onto **Queen St E**. Turn **left** at **Elgin St**. Continue onto **St Marys River Dr**. The Hotel will be on the left.

From the US simply follow Michigan's I75 north to the Sault Ste. Marie International border and cross the international bridge. After crossing the bridge go **south** on **Wellington St W** toward **Lyons Ave/Wellington St W**. Turn **left** to stay on **Wellington St W**. Turn **right** at **Huron St**. Slight **left** toward **St Marys River Dr**. Turn **right** at **St Marys River Dr**. The hotel will be on the right

Destination Information
