The Anishinabek Nation FASD Program will be hosting our very first Traditional Medicine Conference under the guidance and input of our Advisory Committee and Elders. - ⇒ Relevance to Traditional Medicines and knowledge.
- ⇒ Clarity and coherence of submission.
- ⇒ We are seeking a broad range of topics and perspectives related to traditional health/medicine. The conference is intended to be of interest to all individuals from beginners to experienced knowledge carriers.

ACCEPTANCE AS A PRESENTER

- ⇒ You may be contacted by a member of the selection committee regarding any questions about your proposal.
- ⇒ Successful applicants will be notified by the Conference Coordinator by June 25, 2018.
- ⇒ Presenters will be provided with a designated time to present by the conference committee.
- ⇒ Payment/Compensation:
 - Travel, meals and accommodations will be covered by the conference budget. Arrangements will be made through the conference coordinator. Further information to follow once submissions are accepted. Hands on activities are encouraged. Any workshop supply costs must be pre-approved by the committee prior to the conference. Submission of original receipts will be required.
 - o A flat rate workshop fee of \$500 will be paid for each accepted workshop proposal. (i.e. if 2 presenters are presenting one workshop together, the fee paid will be \$500 in total). All facilitators will receive asemaa prior to their session and free conference registration.
